Single Handed Open: Three out of three. Briefing at 10am. First race 10.50. Second race 12.10. Third Race TBA. Overall trophy & separate trophy for Allcomers C. *Entry Fee:* £5.

Tri-Icicle - Sponsored by Jeckells: Briefing at 9.30am. Course and duration of race to be decided depending on the conditions. Trophies for Cruisers, Keelboats, Yeomans and Dinghies. SFSC pennant for first RCC. *Entry Fee:* RCC £25, Keelboats £20, Double-Handed Dinghies £15, Single Handers £12. Minimum PY 1250 or less. Entry - both online and by post.

Yeoman Winter Championship: Briefing 10am. First race 10:50am. Second race 12:10. Third TBA. Entry fee £5. Overall trophy and glasses for placing. Leave your boat after the Tri-Icicle for free.

Boxing Day: Allcomers races at 11.15 a.m. and 12.15 p.m. First race for the Boxing Day Spoon and the second race for the Arthur Mann Memorial Trophy and KGFS Pennant. *Entry Fee:* £1 per head per race.

- There will be no dinghy racing without adequate safety cover.
